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### Summary of Accomplishments...

- » We are very proud to report that in all nine accountability measures St. Mary's has performed among the top 25% of Alberta schools and in seven categories we are in the top 5% of Alberta schools!
- » In the Student Learning Measure, we have an impressive 92.2% of students meeting the acceptable standard, 18.8% over the Provincial average. The results are even more impressive in the Excellence category where 33.3% of students achieved the standard of excellence compared to the Provincial average of 19.5%.
- » In the Safe and Caring measure 91.1% of stakeholders expressed satisfaction with the efforts of our school in ensuring students are safe coming to school, while at recess and returning

- home. This is a measure that we take very seriously and we will continue to find ways of ensuring all students feel safe, cared for and included.
- » In the Education Quality measure an outstanding 95.8% of stakeholders were satisfied with the programming and learning at school, this is a 5.7% margin over the provincial average.
- » In the Program of Studies measure, which assesses stakeholder satisfaction with the range of fine arts, technology and physical education, we achieved a 90.9% satisfaction rating. This was a slight improvement of 1.7% over last year and is 9% over the provincial average.
- » The Citizenship measure continues to be a strength at St. Mary's as we once again achieved an overall Excellence rating.

- This is due to intentional programming and dedicated parents, students and staff.
- » In the Parental Involvement measure we continue to ensure we have opportunities for parents to be involved in meaningful volunteer opportunities.
- » At St. Mary's we begin instilling values that contribute to students being successful when they leave school. Our Work Preparation measure decreased this year. We will continue to implement programming that will teach and model learning and study habits, provide for active student leadership opportunities, address studying techniques, and ensure technology skills are integrated into classrooms.
